

The Sound Reading System for Secondary SEN

Sound Reading builds confidence in struggling readers, rapidly. Students start to make sense of words and sounds after just one or two lessons. Each lesson sets the student up for success and they progress quickly. Students who have many learning difficulties also make progress which for many is often the biggest achievement in their school careers. Boys in particular who have developed behavioural problems to hide their struggle with reading, start to feel that they can do as well as their friends and their attitude to learning changes from negative to positive. After 18 hours of Sound Reading, students usually progress 1 to 2 levels in reading, behaviour improves and they are more willing to participate in class Q & A and discussions.

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
